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***Before you commit to adoption, please contemplate the following:***

- When choosing a pet, please consider the life span of the animal in question; dogs and cats live between 10 and 18 years, making them a long-term commitment.
- Pets require training, a proper, balanced diet, regular health checks, and vaccinations.
- There is a continual financial commitment associated with pet ownership; hidden costs are associated with the purchase of food, leashes, collars, litters, toys and licenses, and grooming.
- Some pets in shelters have troubled pasts; please be aware that they may initially exhibit negative behaviors such as chewing, scratching or digging, or eliminating in undesirable areas. Keep in mind that most behaviors can be corrected with proper training.

**Proper care is needed for an animal to lead a happy life.**

## Adoption Prices:

- **\$125.00 unaltered puppies** - there is a \$50.00 refundable spay/neuter deposit required for unaltered puppies. It is returned when a receipt from a veterinarian is presented indicating that the spay/neuter has been completed. It must be received within 6 months of the date of adoption.
- **\$175.00 spayed/neutered dogs/puppies**

*\* Extra costs may be incurred at your veterinary office if additional health procedures or additional vaccinations are required or desired.*

Your adoption fee helps to defray the approximate \$8,000 a month operating expense. A 25% Spay & Neuter Discount Certificate valid at local animal hospitals is included with the adoptions of unaltered animals.

All animals are current on their vaccinations, have been checked for heartworm and have been on heartworm preventatives, wormed if needed, and micro-chipped (includes national registration).

When you adopt an animal from Animal Haven, you will receive an adoption kit filled with goodies and information (including samples of dog and cat food, and/or treats and coupons), free Animal Haven I.D. tags, and your first year of membership. As a yearly member, you will receive a pet-alert membership card, the "Paws for News" newsletter, and will have the opportunity to be an active voice in the society. You will also receive a Lifetime Membership in Animal Haven's Lost & Found Program!
